### **KASHERING OF POTS AND PANS FOR PESACH**

The kashering of pots, pans, and utensils for Pesach will be conducted on Sunday, 13th April from 9.00am to 3.00pm at “The Cottage” in the Jewish Centre, Woodrow Avenue, Yokine. (Entry from the side fence facing Carmel School)

Please ensure that the pots are clean and that the handles have been detached (if possible)

Note: it is preferable that the pots, pans and utensils not be used 24 hours prior to kashering
